**: Taste Perthshire**

**: Cairngorm national park (Driving through)**



Cairngorms National Park is the UK's largest national park, located in the heart of the Scottish Highlands and known for its spectacular landscapes and abundant wildlife. It offers a vast range of outdoor activities and natural beauty.

**: Loch Ness - Fort Augustus**



Fort Augustus is a scenic village in the Scottish Highlands, situated at the southern tip of Loch Ness. The village is cantered around a dramatic "staircase" of five locks designed by Thomas Telford. Watching boats navigate the change in water level between the canal and Loch Ness

**: Loch Ness cruise**

### **: Fort William (Driving through)**



On the way back from Loch Ness, driver will drive through Fort William known for its rugged climbs and nature walks.

### **: Three Sisters of Glencoe**



The Three Sisters of Glencoe are three iconic, steeply-sided mountain ridges located in the Glen Coe valley of the Scottish Highlands. The individual ridges, which are part of the larger Bidean nam Bian mountain massif, are named Beinn Fhada (Long Hill), Gearr Aonach (Short Ridge), and Aonach Dubh (Black Ridge). For the photo opportunity and test of Scottish Highland explore driver will stop at

the Three Sisters of Glencoe.

### **: Meeting of the Three Waters**



The Meeting of the Three Waters refers to a picturesque natural location in Glen Coe, in the Scottish Highlands. It is a confluence where three specific rivers (or streams) meet amidst a dramatic mountain landscape. For the photo opportunity and test of Scottish Highland explore driver will stop at the Meeting of the three Waters.

### **: Rannoch Moor (Driving through)**



Rannoch Moor, often described as one of the last true wildernesses in Britain, served as a significant filming location for the Harry Potter film series, primarily representing the desolate, wild landscapes through which the Hogwarts Express travels.

Iconic Scenes Filmed at Rannoch Moor

- The Death Eater Ambush (Deathly Hallows: Part 1): This is the most famous scene associated with the moor. In this sequence, Death Eaters board and search the Hogwarts Express while it is traveling across the bleak, boggy landscape.

- Dementor Attack (Prisoner of Azkaban): Some sources also note the moor's atmosphere was used to depict the landscape during the Dementor attack on the train in the third film.
- Horcrux Journey (Deathly Hallows: Part 1): The vast, marshy expanse provided a backdrop for Harry, Ron, and Hermione's treacherous journey through the wilderness.
