: Midhope Castle



Midhope Castle is a 15th-century tower house located on the Hopetoun Estate near South Queensferry, Scotland, best known as the exterior filming location for "Lallybroch" in the TV series Outlander.

: Falkland village



Falkland village in Fife, Scotland, is globally recognized by Outlander fans as the stand-in for Inverness. Its well-preserved 17th and 18th-century architecture and cobbled streets allowed it to portray the Highland city across multiple eras, specifically the 1940s (Season 1) and the 1960s (Seasons 2 and 4).

: Balvaird Castle



Balvaird Castle is a real, well-preserved 15th-century tower house in Perthshire, Scotland, famously used as Castle Leathers, the home of Lord Simon Fraser (played by Tony Curran) in the Outlander prequel series, Blood of My Blood

: Sheep Bridg



The "sheep bridge" in the Outlander universe is the iconic stone bridge featured in the prequel series Outlander: Blood of My Blood, where Brian Fraser and Ellen MacKenzie first meet and their love story begins.

: Doune Castle



Doune Castle is the last attraction of the tour. This was featured as Castle 'Leoch', Jamie's uncles the MacKenzie's ancestral home. In the series, it is here we are introduced to Ellen, Colum and Dougal. Outside the castle is the secret tunnel which Ellen uses to 'sneak' out of the Castle undetected.
